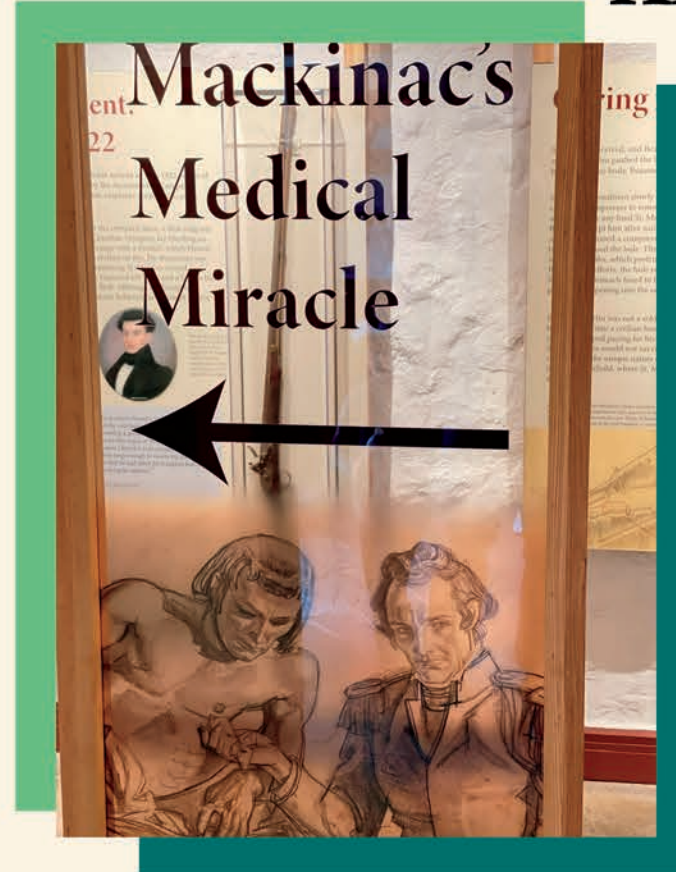

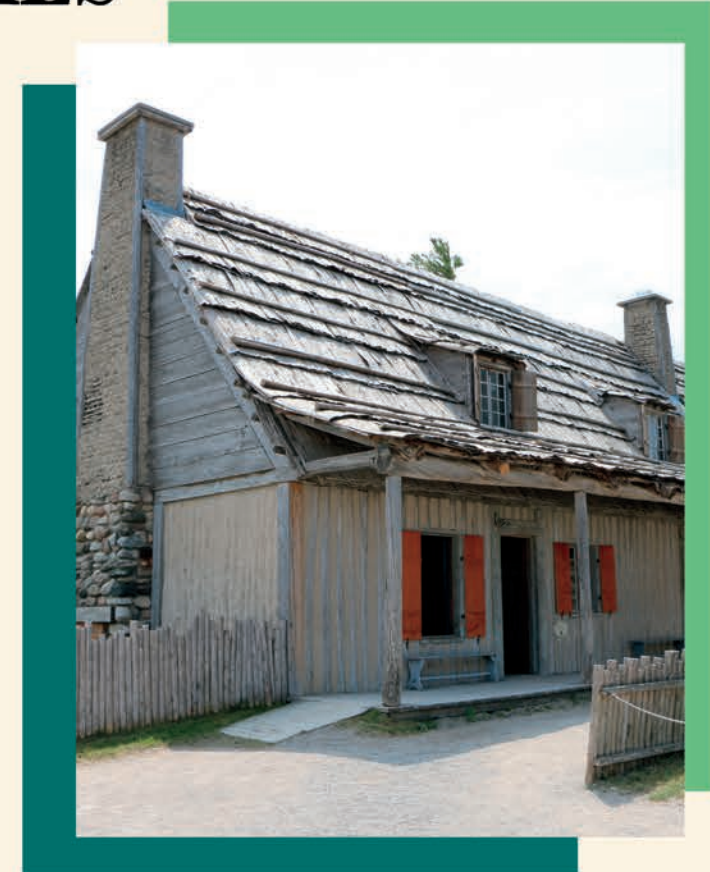

2022 ANNUAL MEETING
